

Sepulveda-Venice Water Pipeline Connection

The Los Angeles Department of Water and Power (LADWP) continues to install an emergency connection to the Metropolitan Water District (MWD) of Southern California's water supply.

Construction Information

Construction began in mid-September 2018 and is scheduled to be completed by late 2020. To reduce the impact to the community, construction of the project is divided into multiple stages.

The first three stages on Sepulveda Blvd. have been completed.

Traffic impacts during Stage 4 and 5 include:

- Bentley Ave. will be closed north of Venice Blvd. Detour signs will be posted.
- There will be no right turn from Venice Blvd. onto Bentley Ave.
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- Westbound traffic lanes on Venice Blvd may be reduced intermittently from 9am to 3pm.
- Signs will be posted to guide traffic through the reduced lanes.
- Traffic lanes will be restriped on Venice Blvd and parking will be restricted during construction.
- Temporary No Parking/Tow-Away signs will be posted as needed.
