mainline water distribution on Riverside Dr, Calhoun Ave, Murieta Ave, Huston St, Tilden Ave, Sylmar Ave, Lennox Ave, Tyrone			
Ave, Katherine Ave, and Stansbury Ave. Construction would include installation of new laterals for fire hydrants. Trenches will be 2			
feet wide and 5 feet deep and will be back-filled with slurry to the base of the asphalt concrete pavement. The purpose of this project			
is to replace aging and leaking infrastructure in order to provide a reliable source of water to LADWP customers.


