Project Title: Scattergood-Olympic Transmission Line Project

Project Location: The Project is located in Los Angeles County, situated in the Los Angeles Basin, south of the Santa Monica Mountains, adjacent to the Pacific Ocean. The proposed underground transmission line alignment would be located in the cities of Los Angeles and Culver City, California. Portions of the proposed alignment would be adjacent to the cities of El Segundo and Santa Monica and the unincorporated community of Marina Del Rey. The SGS is located at 12700 Vista Del Mar, about one mile southwest of the Los Angeles International Airport (LAX). The Olympic RS is located at 1840 Centinela Avenue, approximately one mile northwest of the Interstate 10/Interstate 405 interchange.

Project Description: The City of Los Angeles Department of Water and Power is proposing to construct and operate approximately 11.4 miles of new 230 kilovolt (kV) underground transmission line that would connect the Scattergood Generating Station (SGS) and Olympic Receiving Station (Olympic RS). The Project would also include minor modifications to the SGS and Olympic RS to allow the new transmission line to connect into the stations. The addition of a new underground transmission line would enhance the reliability and operational flexibility of power transferred from the SGS to the Olympic RS.

This is to advise that the City of Los Angeles Board of Water and Power Commissioners has approved the above described Project on July 17, 2012 and has made the following determinations regarding the above described project:

1. The Project [will will not] have a significant effect on the environment.
